#### TRANSLATION SERVICES NEWS

If any family would like to have a meeting or conversation with staff and would like to have a translator available, please let me know and I will set this up. The district has contracted with Language Line translation services. I encourage any family of which English is not the first language to request a meeting at the school and take advantage of this service when needed.

#### **INTERVENTION NEWS**

This week and next, our teachers, interventionists, and coaches are reviewing all screeners and assessments thus far to establish small group instruction in the classroom and out of the classroom for Tier 2 and Tier 3 literacy and math. Up to this point, our intervention staff has been pushing in to classrooms to assists students in their learning. With this new data, we can plan for more focused interventions.

We take a similar approach with behavior at OSW. If a student is struggling with behaviors, the classroom teacher is responsible for implementing strategies and collecting data for several weeks. If the behavioral struggles continue, the classroom teacher brings the student information to our Behavior Team to brainstorm more intensive strategies tied to specific behaviors.

When students show success with these strategies, they may continue intervention support or be released back to Tier 1 (in-the-classroom) support. If the staff feels they have exhausted their resources over an extended period, we may consider evaluations to determine if the child has a disability. Then, we enter the PPT process with the family.

This is just a broad sweep of our process. If you have concerns about your child's learning, please start with the classroom teacher, and we will make sure your child gets what they need.

On a celebratory note, I am looking forward to our OSO's first Fall Fest on Saturday, Oct. 21 at 12pm!

As many of you may have heard, the government is planning on opening up free Covid test kits via COVID.gov as of MONDAY SEPTEMBER 25, 2023.

How to prepare for a fall or winter Covid-19 surge

Though late summer has brought a surge of Covid-19 due largely to new variants, it's possible the fall and winter seasons may bring another uptick in infections. If you're looking for ways to protect yourself in addition to stocking up on tests, updated booster shots are now available.

The CDC recommends everyone ages 6 months and older receive a new Moderna or Pfizer vaccination to protect against serious illness.

The symptoms for the latest Covid-19 variant making waves, EG.5 or "Eris," are similar to those of previous strains and can include:

Fatigue Sore throat Runny nose Fever Muscle aches Loss of taste and smell

If you're feeling under the weather with some or all of those symptoms, it's a good idea to take a test.







## UCFS Healthcare

#### UCFS Healthcare's School-Based Health Centers and Your School!

The UCFS school-based health centers (SBHC) are a doctor's office inside of your school. The services are provided by an APRN (advanced practice registered nurse)/PA (Physician Assistant) and licensed behavioral health clinician who are experts in adolescent health and are employed by UCFS. The intention of the UCFS SBHC is to supplement the care your child receives at their pediatrician's office.

- Acute care visits (e.g. sick visits, lacerations, injuries, etc.)




